

Nanhua University Student On Campus Scholarship Set Up Guidelines

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1. Purpose

Nanhua University (hereinafter referred to as the University) set up the “Nanhua University Student On Campus Scholarship Set Up Guidelines” (hereinafter referred to as these guidelines) to award the club model, outstanding academic and service learning performance students.

2. Type of scholarship

These guidelines were set for the 4 types of scholarships below (cannot apply multiple scholarships):

- a. Fo Guang scholarship
- b. Club excellence scholarship
- c. Academic excellence scholarship
- d. Volunteer service scholarship

3. Fo Guang scholarship

- a. Target of award: Undergraduate (bachelor degree, advanced bachelor degree) students with well academic and behavioral performance, good spirit of service and outstanding competition achievement that can be model to other students.
- b. Application qualifications:
 - (1) Obtain 80 marks in the academic result and 85 marks in the behavioral result, and no rules violation record.
 - (2) Voluntarily service for 30 hours and perform well.
 - (3) Take part in club activities as cadre and achieve Grade A in campus or off campus club evaluation.
 - (4) Participate in national or international competition on behalf of the University, and achieve the top three ranking.
- c. Quota and amount of scholarships: This scholarship will be given to a few students each academic year. Each student will receive NTD 20,000 and a certificate.
- d. Review standard: The University Scholarship Review Committee will review and decide according to student's comprehensive performance of academic result, behavioral result, service contribution, club performance and participation in national and international competition on behalf of the University.

4. Club excellence scholarship

- a. Target of award: Students who use spare time to take part in club activities with

enthusiasm or become a club leader, responsible, have leadership and can be model to other students.

- b. Application qualifications:
 - (1) Obtain 80 marks of academic result and 85 marks of behavioral result, and no rules violation record.
 - (2) Become leader or deputy leader (club leader, association leader, team leader), manage club affairs, organize activities with well performance, and achieve Grade A in campus or off campus club evaluation (each club is limited to one person to apply for this scholarship).
 - c. Quota and amount of scholarships: This scholarship will be given to a few students each academic year. Each student will receive NTD 10, 000 and a certificate.
 - d. Review standard: If the results meet the requirements, students who took part in national competition will have the priority to get the scholarship compared to those who took part in local competition. If club performance is the same, students who achieve better academic result will have the priority to get the scholarship. All review and decision are made by The University Scholarship Review Committee.
5. Academic excellence scholarship
- a. Target of award: Undergraduate (bachelor degree, advanced bachelor degree) students with excellent academic result.
 - b. Application qualifications: Students of this University with excellent academic result in the past academic year, which are the first 10 % ranking in class, and each semester must meet the minimum required credits and no subject failed. Obtain 85 marks of behavioral result and no rules violation record.
 - c. Scholarship amount: NTD5000 and 1 certificate for every student.
 - d. Review standard: Dean of department recommend a student in every class according to one's academic result, host a position in class, take part in department affairs, and love to service. Two students can be recommended if the number of students is more than 41(inclusive) in a class. The name list of students should be handled to Student Affairs Office within the first two weeks of a semester by every department. All review and decision are made by The University Scholarship Review Committee.
 - e. Basis for calculating the number of students in a class: the number of students set by the Ministry of Education and reported by Academic Affairs Office on March 15 of the current year.
6. Volunteer service scholarship
- a. Target of award: Undergraduate (bachelor degree, advanced bachelor degree) Volunteer students with excellent service learning performance, responsible and can be model to other students.
 - b. Application qualification:

- (1) Obtain 80 marks of academic result in the past academic year and 85 marks of behavioral result, and no rules violation record.
 - (2) Have a volunteer service record book.
 - c. Quota and amount of scholarship: The actual number of volunteer service hours in the academic year reaches the reward standard. Each student will receive a certificate and cash amount as following:
 - (1) Students worked in between 150 and 250 hours can receive NTD 3000.
 - (2) Students worked in between 250 and 500 hours can receive NTD 6000.
 - (3) Students worked more than 500 hours can receive extra NTD8000.
 - (4) Each service hour of participation in international volunteer service may calculate as 1.5 hours.
 - d. Review standard: Hours of participation in courses and activities such as overseas study, expatriate teaching, overseas internship, etc. are not counted as service hours. All review and decision are made by The University Scholarship Review Committee.
7. For articles 3, 4, 5, and 6 of these guidelines, the past academic year's academic result, behavioral result, administrative sanctions, voluntary service hours, club performances, and participation in national or international competitions on behalf of schools is calculated. The deadline for accepting applications will be announced in further notice. The acceptance time shall not be less than two weeks.
8. Scholarship Review Committee
- The Scholarship Review Committee is established to determine the quota and amount of scholarships stipulated in these guidelines.
- The review committee is convened by the vice president supervising school affairs, the dean of Student Affairs Office, Academic Affairs Office and each college as committee members, and the leader of Student Assistance Division as executive secretary.
- The review committee of the preceding paragraph is non paid position. Relevant personnel may be invited to attend if necessary.
9. The amount of the above scholarships will be adjusted according to the budget of the current year, and will be announced after the approval of the principal.
10. These guidelines were approved by Executive Meeting, and announced for implementation after principal approval. Any amendment will undergo the same procedure.
