Exchange students are required to purchase the basic package for Room and Board. **We currently do not offer meal plans.** Students will need to pay an associated \$50 housing application fee, a \$200 security deposit, and a \$20 mailbox fee. The security deposit is fully refundable when the room is returned in good condition.

International students are required to enroll in at least 12 units per semester (4 registered courses) and are required to purchase student health insurance here in the US. Currently, this costs \$139 per month. (This amount may increase as it is regulated by a health insurance company. UWest cannot control the cost of health insurance.)

Finally, the student’s books, food, other materials, airport pickup, incidental expenses, and travel costs are not included in the costs listed above and are the responsibility of each individual student.

\* All rates and fees are subject to change upon advance wrote notice.

\* In order for the form I-20 to be issued, please provide at least \$6,700 USD bank verification for one semester and \$13,400 USD for two semesters. This amount is an estimate based on typical average costs. Actual costs may be higher or somewhat lower depending on a student’s particular circumstances. This is the minimum amount needed for the bank statement for the I-20. However. It came to our attention that counselor officials may view your bank statement with higher amounts more favorable.
