課程說明：

1. 本所研究生畢業時至少應修滿 36 學分，包括專業必(選)修 6 學分、專業選修 24 學分、論文 6 學分。
2. 學生於申請學位考試前，需至「臺灣學術倫理教育資源中心」線上平台自行修習「學術倫理教育」課程，並通過課程總測驗及成績達及格標準。
3. 大專/大學非觀光、餐旅、休閒相關科系畢業，且未取得導遊、領隊證書者或國民旅遊領團人員認證者，須通過本所之鑑定考試，未通過者須修畢「觀光旅遊學」課程，其課程不列入畢業學分。

4. 選修之外所課程須與本所專業選修課程同名稱，使得認定為畢業學分。
5. 本所研究生入學後，修習「旅遊產業分析」模組課程12學分(含)以上、「旅遊事業管理」6學分(含)以上或「主題旅遊實務專題」模組課程6學分(含)上，可由本系出具備該模組之專業能力證明。
6. 畢業前若取得考試院核發之導遊、領隊等證照，則可折抵領隊與導遊實務專題一科。
7. 畢業前須完成下列非正式課程之要求：
 - (1) 學術期刊或研討會論文1篇、碩士論文1篇
 - (2) 非在職生身分者需完成職涯輔導1次、實務講座1場、企業參訪1次；若為在職生身分者提出申請，經查證屬實得免除。

Course Description :

1. At least 36 credits should be completed by the graduate students, including 12 credits for required (optional) courses, 18 credits for elective courses, and 6 credits for dissertation:
2. Before applying for degree examination, students need to take the academic

ethics education course on the Center for Taiwan Academic Research Ethics Education online platform. In addition, they need to pass the final exam and get a passing grade.

3. Those who graduated from colleges/universities not related to tourism, Hospitality, and leisure, and who have not acquired the certification of tour guides, tour leaders or national tourism leaders, must pass the appraisal examination by the department.

Furthermore, the graduate students who would not pass the appraisal examination by the department fulfill the course "Tourism" it can not be recognized as the threshold of graduation credits at the department.

4. The elective courses taken by the graduate student in other departments must be the same as the elective ones in this department, and the courses are recognized as graduation credits.

5. After enrolling in the department the graduate students have to take 12 credits in the or more of the module course "Tourism Industry Analysis", 6 credits, be recognized and waived for the course the module as will. It can be issued by this department to prove the professional ability of this module.

6. Before graduation, if the graduate students acquire the tour guide and tour leader but the other licenses issued by the examination institute, you can discount the subject of tour leader and tour guide practice.

7. The following informal course requirements must be completed before graduation: (1) 1 academic journal or seminar paper, and once master thesis must be required (2) Those who are not students need to complete once career counseling, once practical lecture, and once; However, it may be certified to be waived for the above requirements if the in-service graduate students submit the related applications in-service graduate students.
